

## **Etsuaki Yoshida**

Dr. Yoshida started his career as a central banker at Bank of Japan, mainly in charge of research on international financial markets. In 2007, he moved to JBIC, a government-owned bank, and conducted policy implementation including Islamic finance, sovereign finance to Africa, and sovereign risk analysis.

He teaches Islamic Finance at Waseda Graduate School of Finance since 2008 as Visiting Associate Professor.

Dr. Yoshida is a frequent speaker at international conferences on Islamic finance, mainly for regulators and practitioners, including World Islamic Banking Conference, Islamic Banking Summit Africa, Sukuk Summit and those by Islamic Financial Services Board.

He authored three books on Islamic Finance in Japanese, as well as publications in English including "Japan: A Comprehensive Picture of Islamic Finance" in "The Islamic Finance Handbook".

Etsuaki received Ph.D from Kyoto University, and B.A. from Hitotsubashi University in Tokyo, after attending Harvard University.
