Mehdi Hadian is a Ph.D. candidate in the faculty of economic and political sciences at Shahid Beheshti University, Iran. From undergraduate to postgraduate program, he has been awarded as a top student. Furthermore, he has taught as a teaching assistant, instructor and lecturer in undergraduate and graduate programs for six years. His research interests include monetary economics, financial economics and macroeconomics. More specifically, he surveyed the 2007 global financial crisis in his master dissertation. This led him to extend his PhD thesis to include the interaction between financial systems and macroeconomics through a policy model within the context of micro-founded macroeconomic model. To this end, a New Keynesian dynamic stochastic general equilibrium model with real-financial linkages is being constructed to analyze the impact of financial shocks, monetary policy and macroprudential regulations on the Iran economy. He is also collaborating in research projects of Islamic Economics Research Center at SBU.
